[Bellefaire JCB](#) will bring games for kids of all ages

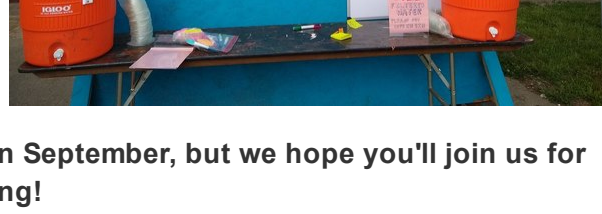
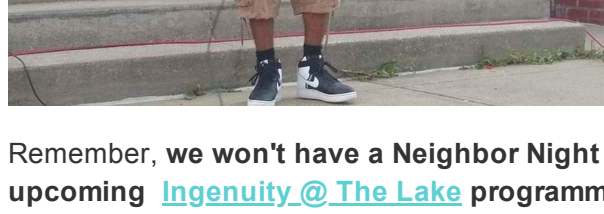
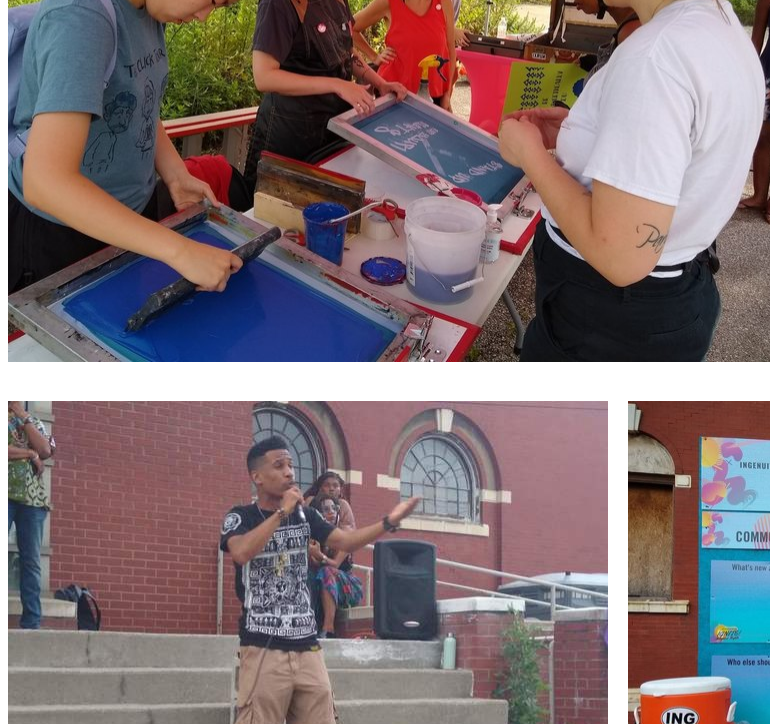
[Step Forward](#) will have all sorts of information about their many programs, from Community Services and Emergency Services, to utility bills payment and COVID-19 emergency assistance.

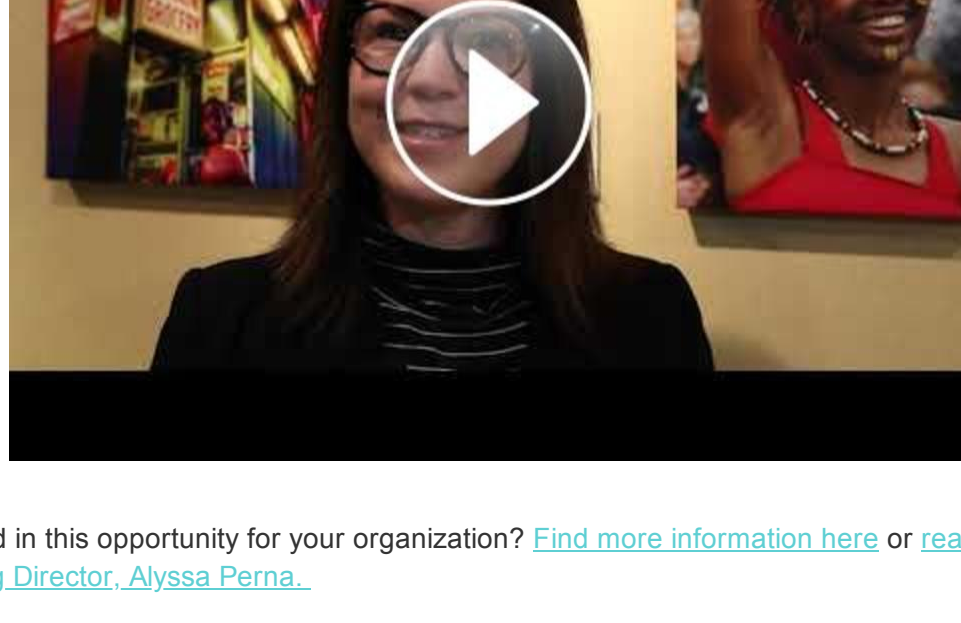
### Ingenious Spaces

### Community Spotlight: Tri-C

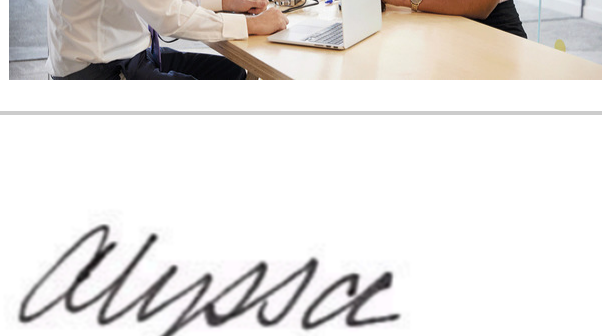
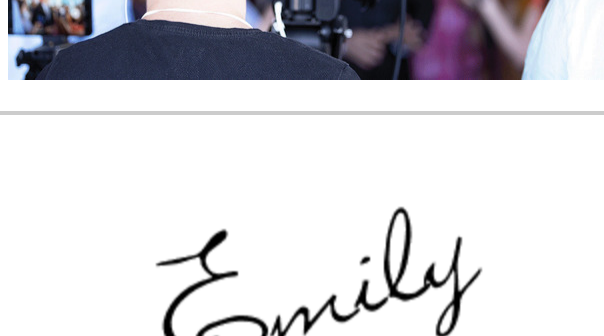
