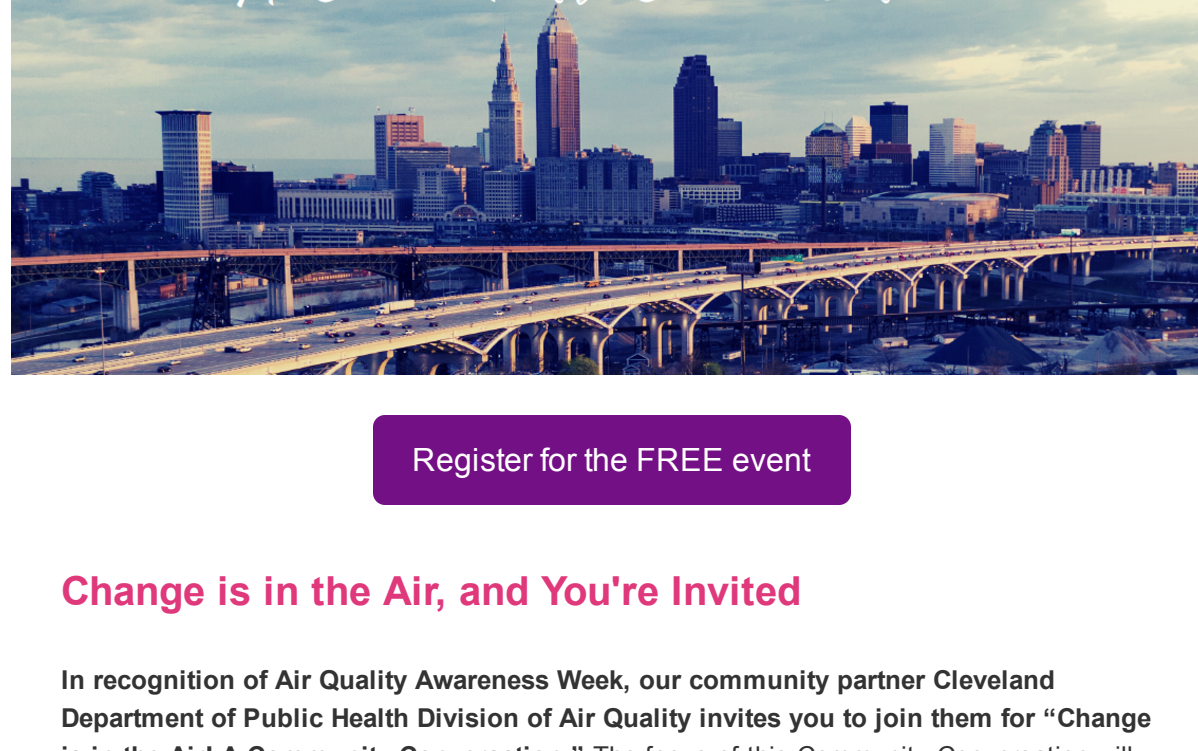


### ListenCLE Crowdfunding Campaign!

As part of our mission, we have been working with local organizations and events such as Destination Cleveland, Assembly for the Arts, the NFL Draft, the NBA All-Star Game, Ingenuity Cleveland, Cleveland Public Library, Playhouse Square, and the Rock Hall to coordinate buskers, street performers, and venue performances during highlight events and regular programming downtown. 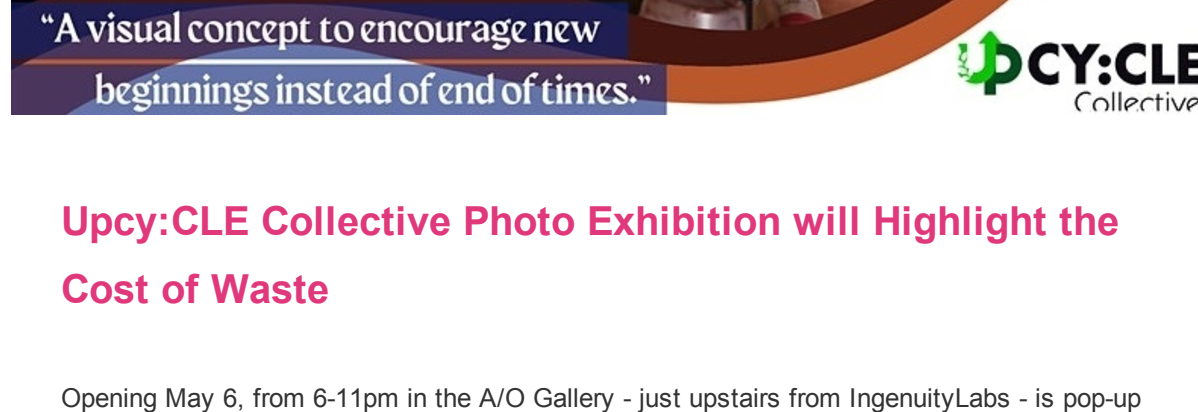
### Change is in the Air, and You're Invited

In recognition of Air Quality Awareness Week, our community partner Cleveland Department of Public Health Division of Air Quality invites you to join them for "Change is in the Air! A Community Conversation." The focus of this Community Conversation will be on Air Quality, Asthma, Environmental Justice and Your Health, and Community Air Monitoring. The event will be held on Wednesday, May 4, 2022 from 2:00 PM-5:00 PM at the Cleveland Public Library Main Branch Louis Stokes Learning Commons 2nd Floor. 525 Superior Avenue Cleveland, OH 44114

We will address the relationship between local air pollution and asthma prevalence throughout the City of Cleveland. This Community Conversation is intended for all members of the community with an interest in air pollution, environmental justice and/or asthma including patients and their family members and caregivers; school administrators, teachers and school nurses, community leaders and medical professionals.

Panelists include participants from the healthcare industry, environmental justice community, and individuals involved in citizen science and community air monitoring projects.

Opening May 6, from 6-11pm in the A/O Gallery - just upstairs from IngenuityLabs - is pop-up art exhibition by Upsy:CLE Collective, *A Last Supper*. The exhibit will run for 30 days.

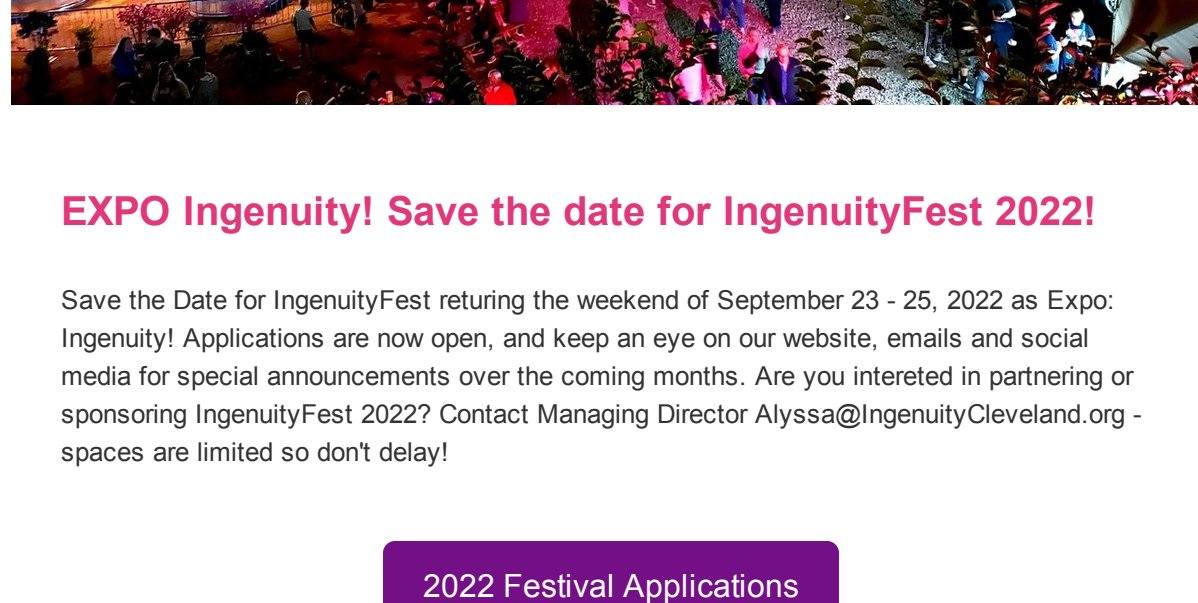
The photography and art editorial explores our relationships with waste, aesthetic demands, and convenience culture. The design and work behind the shoot provide an example of reuse, intersectionality, and community.

Upsy:CLE Collective looks to create a bridge to more collaboration and innovation in Cleveland, especially regarding sustainability. The collective is aiming to empower local education about environmentalism while inspiring artistic creativity.

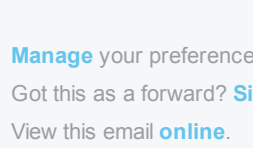
