




We kicked off 2022 with a slam dunk event, and plenty more planned for the future!




The best is yet to come!

In 2022, we will once again be a proud presenting partner for the Metrohealth Juneteenth Freedom Fest in Downtown Cleveland; continue our work producing the #VoicesOfCLE Public Art Initiative; activate our neighborhood's lakefront spaces; and look forward to hosting our signature events, the Ingenuity Bal and the highly anticipated IngenuityFest in September.

We are making permanent upgrades which serves all of the artists & entrepreneurs who call our space home, and collaborate together in support of these initiatives. We kicked off the year with a deep cleaning of IngenuityLabs, and made important investments that included installing energy-efficient LED lighting in 50,000 square feet of workshop space that our community uses daily. We invite you to see for yourself by joining or partnering with us for Ignite! Entrepreneurship Series, Ignite! Neighbor Nights or public art workshops where Cleveland's creatives can network, share skills, and grow - or perhaps even take advance of our Ignite! Impact Awards, typically granted to 10 or more creatives from backgrounds underrepresented in entrepreneurship.






The #VoicesOfCLE Public Art Initiative Continues at Cleveland Hopkins Airport


