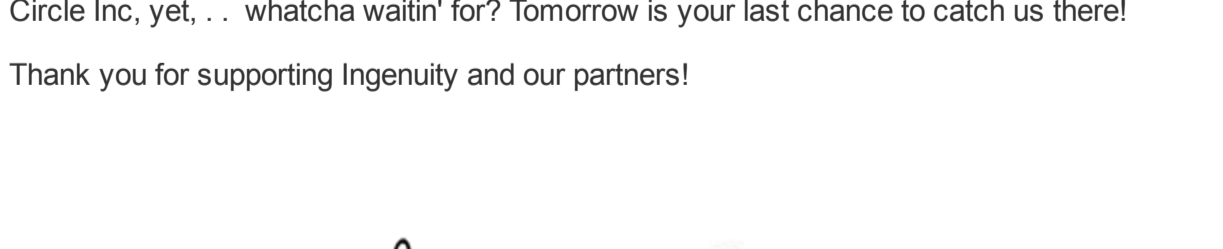
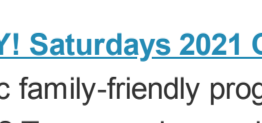
Community Spotlight: Tri-C

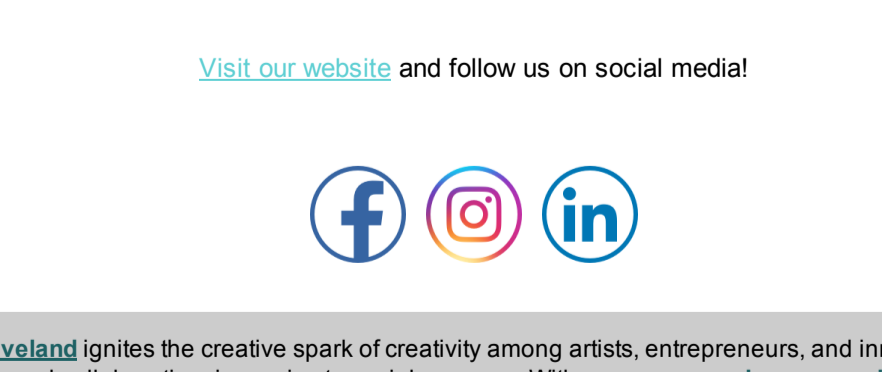

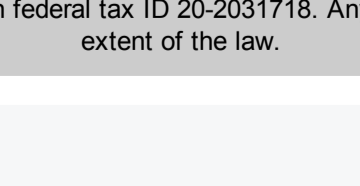
