Sunset is looking spectacular for Ingenuity at the Lake, and while we might encounter a little drizzle in the early hours, we're still set to have a swingin' time. As a reminder, we'll offer THREE PLACES TO PARK and experience lakefront views:

- Enter our event site at the City of Cleveland's Gordon Park (South Gordon Park) off East 72nd Street just south of the freeway. Look for signage and follow GPS to "Gordon Park" or the Intersection of East 72nd and Gordon Park Boulevard.
- If you have more limited mobility or little ones who aren't up for a gentle stroll, park directly at North Gordon Park, nearest the East 72nd Street Boat Launch. The Address 3701 North Marginal Road will get you close, then follow signs.
- Overflow parking is available at the East 72nd Street Reservation Fishing Area, and a pleasent lakefront stroll will also bring you to the Lake Front Stage and connection to the rest of the event.



Why The Lakefront? Why Now?

Ingenuity at the Lake is a culmination of our year-long neighborhood programming, activating our community through <u>monthly Ignite! Neighbor Nights in Saint Clair Superior</u>, and our series of <u>Hip! Hooray! Popups</u> with partners from the Cleveland Metroparks, Famicos Foundation, and the CHEERS initiative.

As part of its core focus, Ingenuity at the Lake will shed light on the Metroparks-led <u>Cleveland</u> <u>Harbor Eastern Embayment Resilience Study (CHEERS)</u>, highlighting the natural and civic resources the study seeks to bolster, and activating a key CHEERS site along the lakefront next to East 72nd Street's Cleveland Lakefront Nature Preserve. Ingenuity will showcase additional partner planning projects including Bike Cleveland's Safe Routes to Parks initiative and an upcoming Famicos Foundation-led masterplan.

The event is set up to emphasize the pathways and connections that bring residents to the Lakefront, so Lace up your walking shoes and plan on one of the routes above!
